Sacramento Asian Pacific Chamber of Commerce Foundation

The Sacramento Asian-Pacific Chamber of Commerce Foundation is pleased to present this scholarship opportunity to students in need of financial assistance in undergraduate and graduate education. Scholarships will be awarded for the Fall of 2008. Eligible students must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be either a high school senior or a full time college student with a minimum course load of 12 units each semester.
2. Must be a resident of the Greater Sacramento Region, unless relocated due to studies.
3. Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident and demonstrate support for the Asian Community.
4. Must have at least one biological parent of Asian Pacific Islander heritage.
5. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
 - A. Please submit an official transcript that contains the student's class rank, grade point average in a sealed envelope.
6. Submit a resume citing activities, background, other scholarships received, and community involvement.
7. Submit a 1 ½ page (2 page max) essay about yourself and describe your financial needs and how the scholarship will help you expedite your graduation.
8. Minimum of two written references or letters of recommendations — one from school and one from either an employer or community organization. The letters should detail your background, achievements, leadership abilities and community involvement.
9. Final applicants may be required to interview with the Sacramento Asian-Pacific Chamber of Commerce Foundation Scholarship Committee.

Completed application and all attachments must be postmarked no later than **WEDNESDAY, APRIL 30, 2008**. No late applications will be accepted.
